Our Mission

Nepal Orphans Home (NOH) attends to the welfare of Nepali children who are orphaned, abandoned, or not supported by their parents. NOH provides for the children's basic needs of food, shelter, and clothing, as well as schooling and health care. We also administer to their emotional needs with love and compassion, allowing the children to grow up in a nurturing environment. Our mission is not just to rescue the children from poverty, but to enable them to develop and realize their potentials.



Our Organization

Nepal Orphans Home, established in 2005, is a charitable organization, administered in North Carolina, with operations in Nepal. NOH operates five children's homes for more than 130 boys and girls in Dhapasi, located in the Kathmandu Valley. The children are orphans or have parents unable to provide for them. Most of the children in the homes are girls, since they are more likely to be subjected to abuse and deprivation in Nepal. More than half of our girls have been rescued from lives of bonded servitude in western Nepal. Additionally NOH supports a village school, serving mostly Dalit (untouchable) children, in the Ramechhap district and a small school for poor Sherpa children in northeastern Nepal.



Our Goals

Nepal Orphans Home is a grassroots organization supporting what its founder, Michael Hess, has committed his life to doing: rescuing Nepali children from deplorable living conditions and giving them a chance to grow up with an education and health care. Along with these basic rights, the children experience a happier childhood, a safer environment, three meals a day, a bed to sleep in, and suitable clothing. Such ordinary expectations for children, but not so ordinary in the lives of many Nepali children.
